FROM THE PASTOR..., July and August Devotional

Ephesians 6:10-13 -

- 10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his power.
- 11 Put on the whole armor of God, so that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.
- 12 For our struggle is not against enemies of blood and flesh, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers of this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places.
- 13 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, so that you may be able to withstand on that evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm.

This story about four women came to me on Facebook several times in the last few days. Each time I read it, I heard the Holy Spirit tell me something different, for that day or time or place. Read it. Think about it. Pray about it.

Four women: Tamar, Rahab, Ruth, and Bathsheba. One had affairs, one was a prostitute, one lied, one was an adulteress... none of them were starry eyed perfect princesses. Four broken women. And yet God chose them...

these four broken women, to be grandmothers in Jesus' family tree. He crowned them with grace and love. Queens for His kingdom.

Today you may feel broken. You may feel like an outsider, a has-been, a never-been. Weary of being taken advantage of, of being unnoticed, uncherished, and unappreciated. Like you don't fit in, like you don't know how to keep going, or what to believe, or where to go. You may feel like you want to give up.

And yet God chooses you. He grafts you into His line, His story, and His heart. He gives you His name, His lineage, and His righteousness. He calls you His very own.

Everyone who has ever tried to live the Christian life would admit that it is a struggle. Our vision is so limited that we only see the physical things with which we wrestle. We focus on ourselves, our circumstances, and others. In the later portions of Ephesians, chapter 6, the apostle Paul attempts to redirect our sights. He tells us our struggle is not really with flesh and blood, those things upon which we most often focus. Our real conflict is spiritual and with spiritual forces!

This is one of those passages we must read with the eyes of faith. We cannot see with our physical eyes the things about which Paul speaks. More important, Paul discusses how we may have victory in this conflict, which we accept we are in by faith.

God has called us for this time and this place. Accept that we can have victory in everything we do for God! Come as you are and worship the king! Amen!


