From the Pastor... March Devotional



"And Jesus came and said to them, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

Matthew 28:18-20 NRSV

We are in the midst of our Lenten journey. As I write this, I am thinking about the word disciples, or discipleship. Discipleship is a word that gets thrown around a lot at church. Often, people think making disciples is a specific call or spiritual gift, that is only meant for pastors, missionaries and "super-Christians". Well, this kind of thinking is wrong. Discipleship is not intended for only a select few to carry out. Christ's mandate to make disciples is meant for every one of His followers.

"Disciple" comes from the Greek word that means, "to learn". Historically, the word recognizes a pupil-teacher relationship. Jesus poured Himself into twelve young men by teaching. He spent intimate relational time with them, and then sent them out to proclaim the gospel and do good works. Jesus literally staked His whole ministry on these twelve young men. He was quietly equipping the saints so that they could lead the multitudes.

As we study the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20) and examine the practical ministry models of Jesus, we can conclude that discipleship is: Pouring into others, training them in Word, in Relationships, and in Ministry, so that they might develop as healthy believers who can walk by faith, share their faith and multiply their faith. So what does this all mean for you and for me? The Great Commission is one command - Make Disciples! It goes on to tell us how we are supposed to do that — Go, Baptize, and Teach.

GO – This is understood as a non-negotiable. Jesus is telling all those who recognize His lordship that wherever and however you go, make disciples.

BAPTIZE – Jesus is describing the symbolic gesture of being initiated into His fold. The focus is witnessing.

TEACH – Jesus wants us to teach disciples all that He commanded. By teaching what Jesus taught, the church becomes an extension of His ministry. It's equipping people to obey all that Jesus commanded.



As we continue this Lenten journey, how are we becoming disciples of Jesus Christ? Are we studying His word? Do we share Jesus with others wherever we go? How are we pouring ourselves into others so that they may see Jesus? Are we inviting others to turn to Jesus or turn away from Jesus by our attitudes and actions?

"'Teacher, which commandment in the law is the greatest?' He said to him. "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind." This is the greatest and first commandment. And a second is like it: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.' "
